ZEUGMA by Justin Earl Grant

On the paper absences, excesses, contrasts and subtleties make up a network of emotionality from which they recreate meanings. The poetics of Grant's work urges us to explore around the omissions of our daily interpretations.

Bio of Artist:

Justin Earl Grant is a self-taught artist residing in Houston. He has lived in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania: Buenos Aires and Santiago de Chile in South America. He studied Pure Mathematics in University of Texas before he started his artworks in 2005.

His work has been exhibited both nationally and internationally such: Petit Palacio Gallery (2009), Espacio de Arte UCEMA (2012), and Galería de Arte Buenos Aires Sur (2014) in Buenos Aires Argentina: Casa de la Cultura de Ñuñoa (2014), Casona Puyó (2015), Radicales (2015), Casa de la Cultura de Recoleta (2015), and Espacio Matta (2016) in Santiago de Chile: Amarillo Art Museum (2017), and Houston Public Library (2018) in Texas. His work is in several private collections. Sobre el papel ausencias, excesos, contrastes y sutilezas configuran un entramado cargado de emotividad desde donde se recrean significados. La poética de la obra de Grant insta a explorar en torno a las omisiones de nuestras interpretaciones cotidianas.

Justin Earl Grant es un artista autodidacta que reside en Houston. Él ha vivido en Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; Buenos Aires y Santiago de Chile en América del Sur. Estudió Pure Matemáticas en la Universidad de Texas antes de comenzar sus obras de arte en 2005.

Su trabajo ha sido exhibido tanto a nivel nacional como internacional como: Galería Petit Palacio (2009), Espacio de Arte UCEMA (2012), y Galería de Arte Buenos Aires Sur (2014) en Buenos Aires Argentina; Casa de la Cultura de Ñuñoa (2014), Casona Puyó (2015), Radicales (2015), Casa de la Cultura de Recoleta (2015) y Espacio Matta (2016) en Santiago de Chile; Amarillo Art Museum (2017) y Houston Public Library (2018) en Texas. Su trabajo está en varias colecciones privadas.

Unlike the repetition of the stories already told or the series of finished realisms of the existing machinery of art, the work that Justin Earl Grant exhibits with the title of Zeugma seeks to maintain the surprise, a contingency that results from the encounter with his production.

Discomfort is the starting point towards the search. Human figures are insinuate, but they are only incomplete strokes where one could identify in a flow with other elements also unfinished.

Between rejection and attraction, between opacities and brightness, in desolate landscapes or invented astronomies, it impels us to invent stories, to imagine places, to unleash emotions.

What it projects is light of a lack, of what it is not there, of what it is insinuated, of what it is missing. The lack generates desire. It leaves us desirous, restless, seekers.












